

## **Sprachpraxis Module Exam Module 9 / Module 10 / MA 01 / MA 02 (English 3) WS 2023/2024**

This exam will take place in **Campus Center Hörsaal 1** on **Saturday February 3** from **8.30am to 12.30pm**.

In order to be eligible for this exam, you must have successfully completed three English 3 courses. **Registration will be possible via eCampus up to Friday January 26**. It is your responsibility to remember to register and to check that it has worked. **You can cancel your registration for the exam up to the day before the exam takes place**. If your cancellation is after that, you will need to provide the Prüfungsausschuss with a written excuse within three days of the exam.

This exam is a 4-hour written one. You will be asked to **write a persuasive essay** of 400-600 words in response to one of two current newspaper articles. Lehramt students (including L4) will also be asked to **translate** a short text taken from a recent German news publication into English; MA EAS and EACBS students can choose between the translation or a **reading comprehension** exercise. You can find exam papers from previous years in the Past Exam Papers section of the Sprachpraxis Moodle site (no enrolment key necessary).

All candidates may bring one English-English and one German-German monolingual **dictionary** to use in this exam if they wish. Electronic dictionaries are not permitted. Please note that a thesaurus is not a dictionary and you will not be allowed to use one.

You are strongly advised not to bring any **electronic devices** (such as mobile phones, smartwatches, bluetooth-enabled devices etc.) at all into the exam room. If you choose to do so, they must be **switched off** completely and **placed in your bag** at the front of the room before the exam begins. **Please note that if you are caught in possession of such a device during the exam, this will be considered cheating regardless of what you were doing with it.**

There will be a **seating plan** for this exam. If you have a specific requirement for a seat, please send an email to Fiona Dancy before the registration deadline.

Candidates who need **special exam arrangements** must apply to their exam board before the registration deadline. Please do this as soon as possible and let me know as soon as you have the confirmation.

**There is no “Nachholklausur” – the next opportunity to take the exam will be in July 2024.**
