

DAAD Award goes to Amantia Simixhiu

February 19, 2018 - Once a year, the DAAD Award, which includes a prize money of EUR 1,000, is granted to an international student or PhD candidate at the University of Kassel for outstanding performances. It is funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). The 2017 Award went to Amantia Simixhiu, recognizing her exceptional academic performance as well as her social and intercultural commitment.
