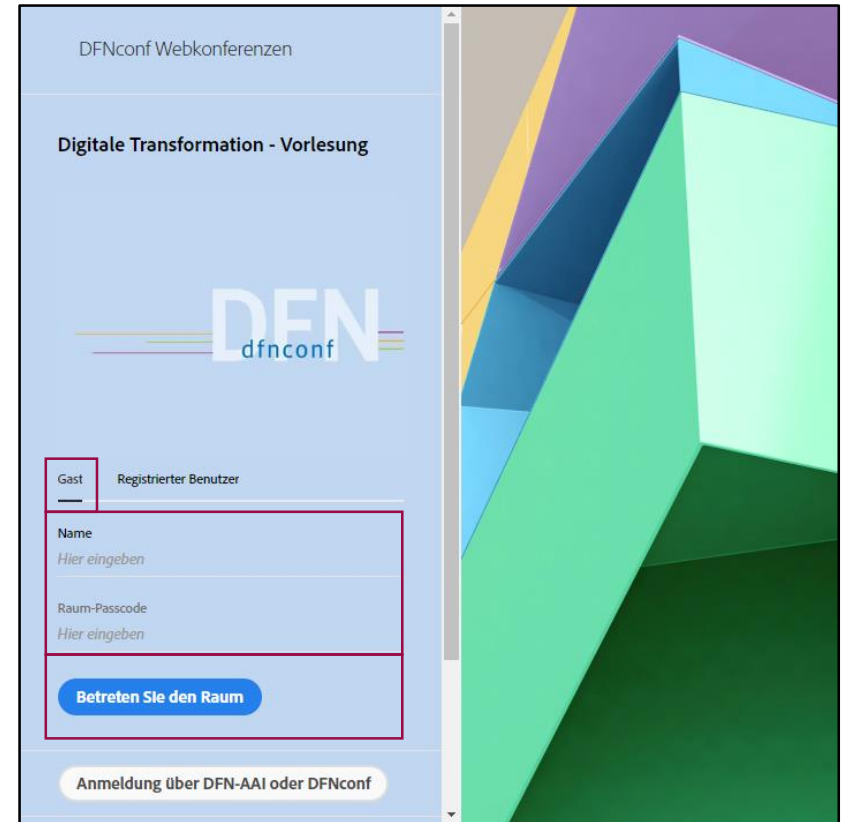

Access through browser (1/2):

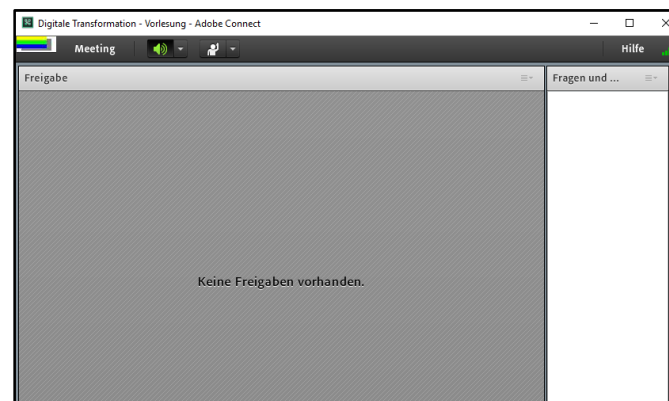
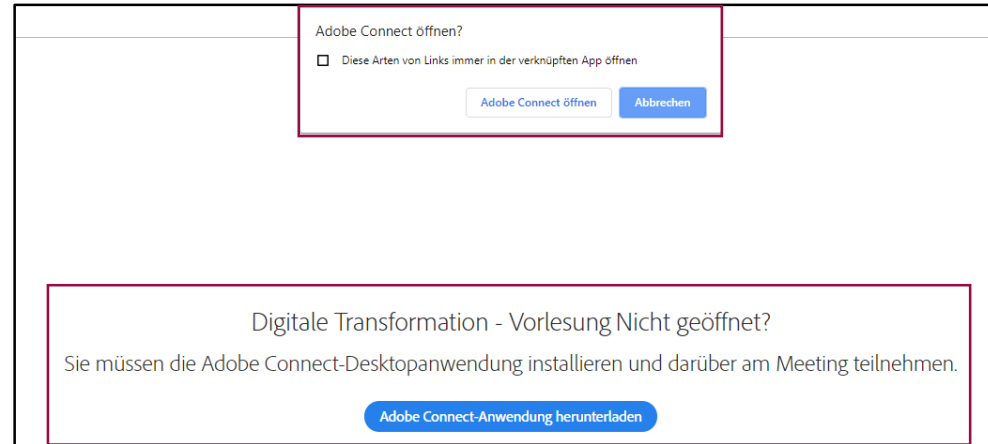
1. Enter link in browser

Access through browser (2/2):

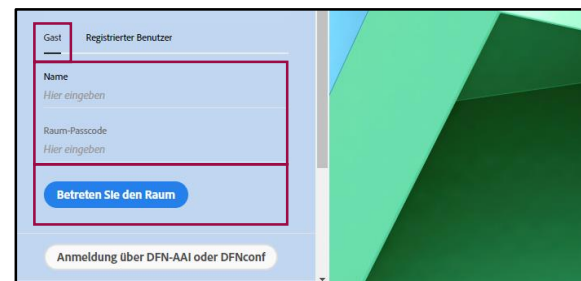
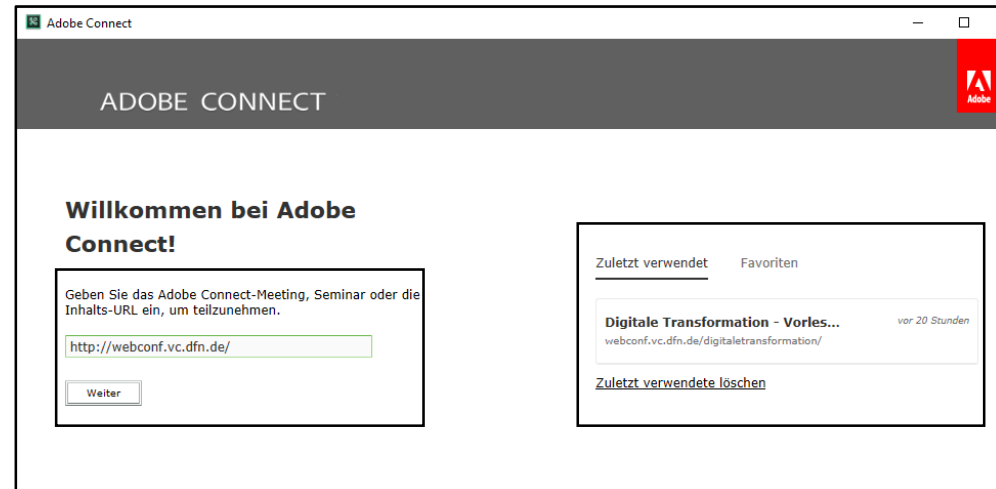
6. Download and install Adobe Connect App

Access directly through Desktop App:

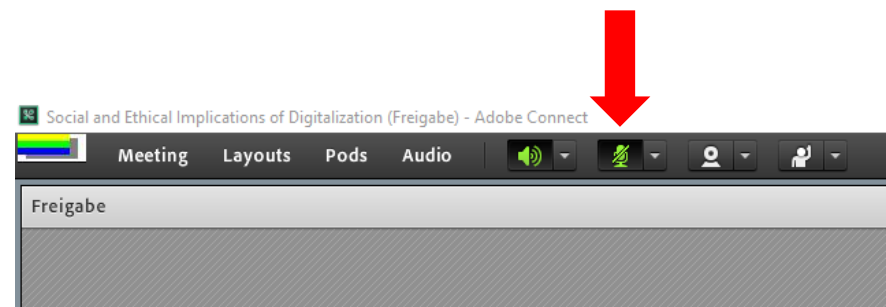
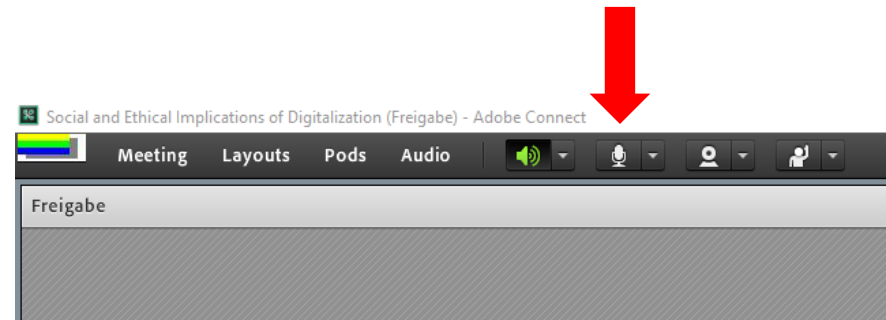
1. Run the Adobe Connect Desktop App

Microphone Functionalities:

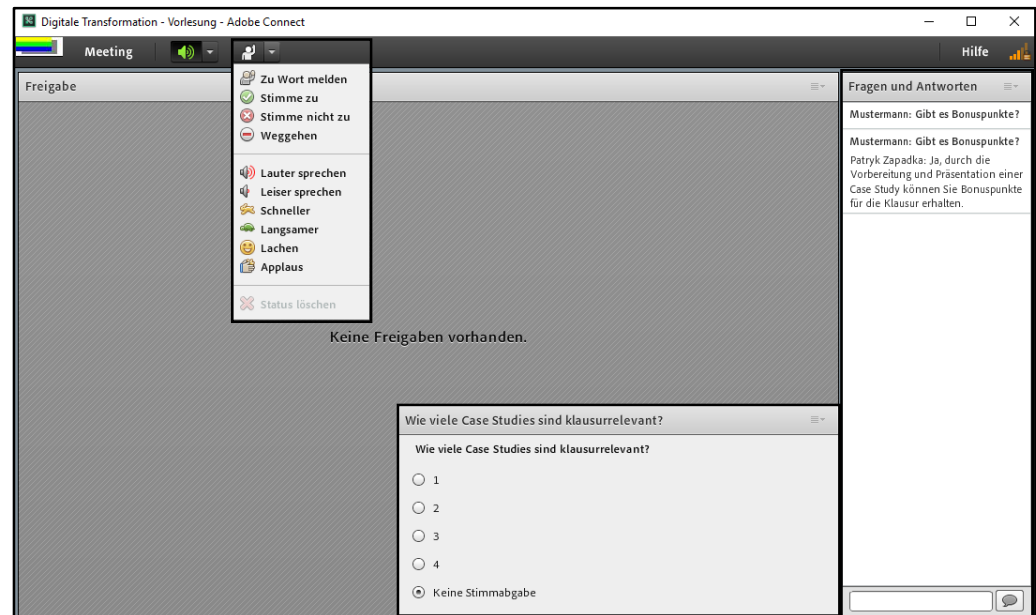
1. Clicking on the microphone symbol activates ability to speak
2. Click on the dropdown menu in order to select a microphone source
3. By once again clicking on the symbol, you mute the microphone
