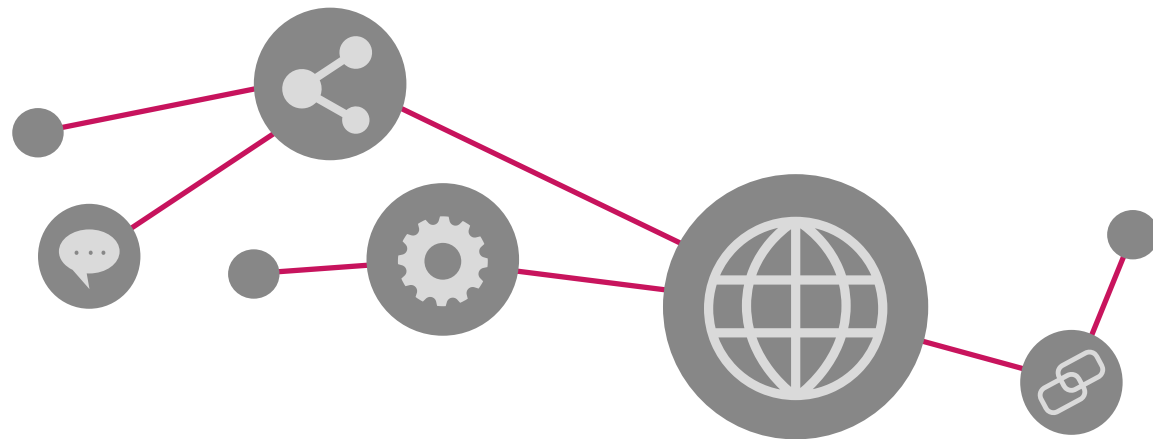


Doctoral Researcher Day

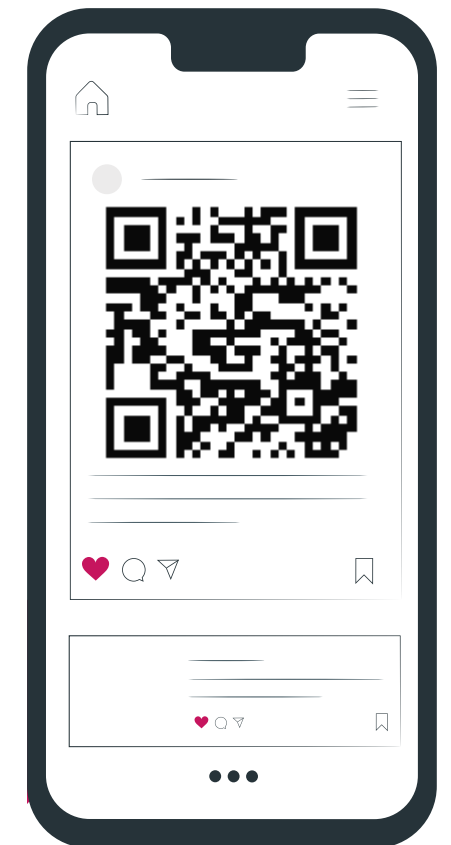
